 to include the 31st day of October, 1861, and has pay
 due from that date to the present date.

There is due to him 100 Dollars traveling allowance
 from Chickasaw, the place of discharge, to Chickasaw, the
 place of enrolment, transportation not being furnished in kind.

There is due him fifty five Dollars
 He is indebted to the Confederate States 100 Dollars
